

VOICE OF THE INDUSTRY THROUGH COMMUNITY SERVICE CAMP INAGEHI AMPITHEATER CLEARING AND GRADING



Even though the U.S. Economy is struggling, GUCA member Western Summit Constructors, Inc. found the time and resources to help others in the community by giving back through community service efforts.

On March 24, 2012, several Western Summit Constructors employees assisted the Camp Inagehi Christian Bible Camp with some light grading and clearing of the ½ acre site to provide proper drainage for an upcoming amphitheater building needed for summer camp operations.



Camp Inagehi is a non-profit organization funded entirely by camp fees and the donation of individuals and Churches who are interested in Christian camping. The camp is owned and operated by Atlanta Bible Camp consisting of members from the Church of Christ. Campers are accepted regardless of race, creed or religious affiliations.

Cowin Equipment Company provided a rubber tire backhoe and fuel to perform the work and Hertz Rental Equipment provide a dozer to perform the removal of stumps and grading/clearing work.

With the help of GUCA members, the grading needed for the amphitheater building was completed and hundreds of children will now be able to participate in plays and concerts at Camp Inagehi.
